Loctite® HD10 Pneumatic 300 ml Cartridge Dispenser

1. Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully unpack the Loctite[®] HD10 Pneumatic 300 ml Cartridge Dispenser and examine the items contained in the carton. Inspect the unit for any damage that might have occurred in transit. If such damage has occurred, notify the carrier immediately. Claims for damage must be made by the consignee to the carrier and should be reported to the manufacturer.

- 1 Pneumatic Dispenser
- 1 Equipment Manual
- 1 Air Line Adapter Fitting With Gasket

1.3 Container Types

This dispenser is suitable to dispense:

- 300 ml cartridges
- 250 ml tubes when item 989347 is purchased separately

2 Technical Data

Pneumatic supply

- Pneumatic quality Filtered 5 µm, oil-free
- Max Inlet pressure 75 psi - Cartridges
 22 psi - Tubes.

Pneumatic connection 1/4-19 BSPP Quick Connect

3 Operating Theory

The cartridge or tube is pneumatically pressurized and product is ejected from the nozzle while the trigger is pressed.

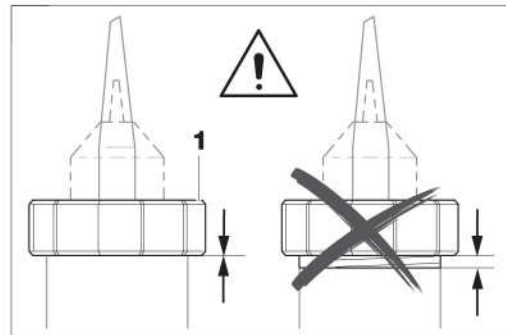
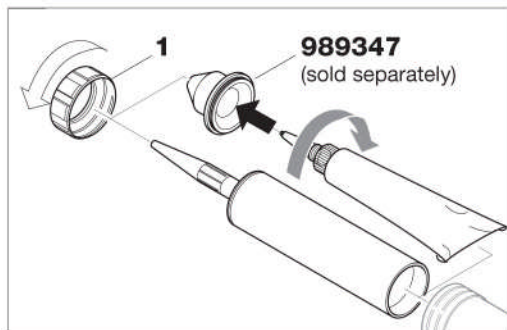
The quantity applied can be adjusted by turning the pressure regulator.

4 Inserting the Cartridge/Tube

- Unscrew the front retaining ring.
- Place the cartridge with the nozzle in the dispenser.
- Screw the tube into the tube adapter 989347 and then assemble it into the dispenser.
- Screw on front retaining ring and tighten.

Caution!

The retaining ring must completely cover the threads to seal the gun.



5 Connecting the Unit

- Connect the unit to an external pneumatic supply.

Caution!

When using cartridges, the pneumatic supply must not exceed 75 psi.

When using tubes, the pneumatic supply must not exceed 22 psi.

6 Nozzle Opening

- Cut off the end of the nozzle as necessary. The amount cut off will determine the size of the nozzle opening. It depends on the viscosity of the product and the desired quantity to be applied.

7 Taking Out of Operation

- Disconnect the pneumatic supply from the unit.

8 Care and Use Tips

The Loctite® dispenser is precision crafted and will last a long time if properly maintained.

- Clean carefully after each use. Take care not to let material harden on components.
- Do not immerse the handle. Internal components will be damaged.
- Make sure screws remain intact and tight.

9 Troubleshooting

Type of malfunction	Possible causes	Correction
No or too little product.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">– No pneumatic supply present.– Pressure regulator is not properly adjusted.– Nozzle opening too small.– Hardening in the nozzle.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide pneumatic supply.• Turn pressure regulator clockwise.• Cut off the end of the nozzle (Section 6).• Replace the nozzle.

10 Warranty
