MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS STOCKING

STEP 1 Fold the paper in half and draw your stocking shape. Then, keeping it folded, cut out your stocking.

STEP 2

Unfold the stocking. Use your Pritt Stick to glue the edges of the stocking, apart from the top edge. Fold the stocking again. Press along the edges of the stocking to glue the seams in place.

STEP 3

Colour or decorate the shapes provided on the template and carefully cut them out.

STEP 4

Use your Pritt Stick to glue these to your stocking. Add some sequins and buttons to make it look more festive!

STEP 5

Punch a hole in the top corner of your stocking and thread a string or ribbon through the hole to make a handle. Hang up your paper stocking and enjoy!

- Pritt Stick
- Paper card
- String or ribbon
- Hole punch
- Buttons, gems & sequins
- Scissors

MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS TREE TWIRLER

STEP 1

Using your paint and paint brushes, paint the paper plate green – remember to leave it to dry!



STEP 2

Whilst waiting for the paper plate to dry, colour or decorate the baubles and decorations provided on the template, and carefully cut them out.



Once your paper plate is dry, use your scissors and carefully cut a spiral into your paper plate to make the Christmas Tree Twirler.

STEP 3



STEP 4

Then take a piece of string and tie a knot in one end. Then staple it into place at the top of your tree.



STEP 5

Next, place the string in-between the two stars and use your Pritt Stick to glue together.



STEP 6

Take your hole punch and make holes into your baubles and Christmas Tree Twirler. Tie on each bauble with a piece of string and enjoy!

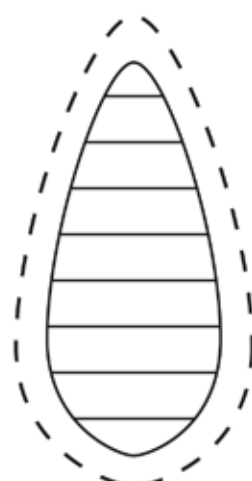
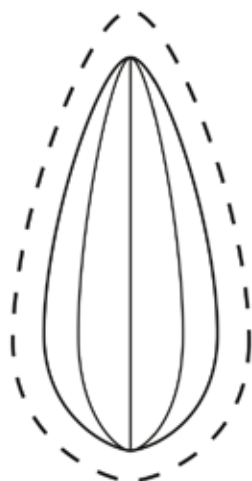
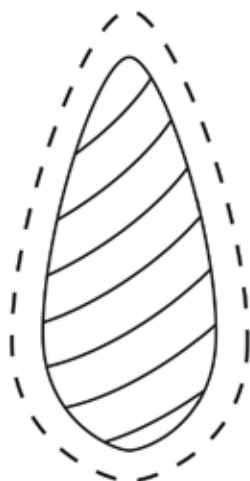
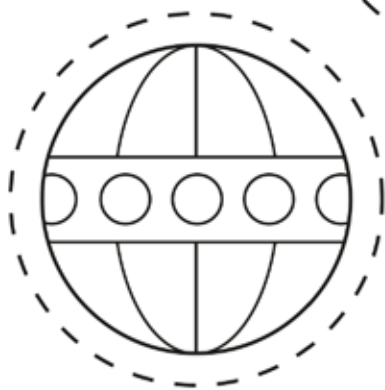
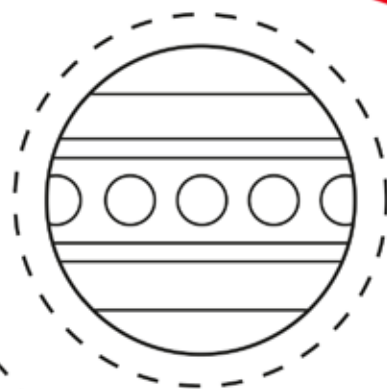
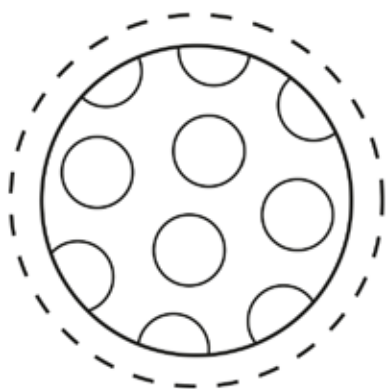


Why not?

MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS TREETWIRLER





MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS CHARACTERS



STEP 1 Cut the individual cups from a recycled egg box and paint them with brown paint. Remember to let them dry!



STEP 3

Colour and cut out the reindeer ears / antlers provided on the template and use your Pritt Stick to glue them onto card to make them sturdy. Finally glue them onto your Rudolph!



STEP 2

Use your Pritt Stick to glue on some googly eyes and a red pom pom for the nose.



STEP 4

Using the template provided, repeat to create the other Christmas characters!

- Pritt Stick
- Egg carton
- Red pom pom
- Googly eyes
- Card
- Brown paint
- Scissors



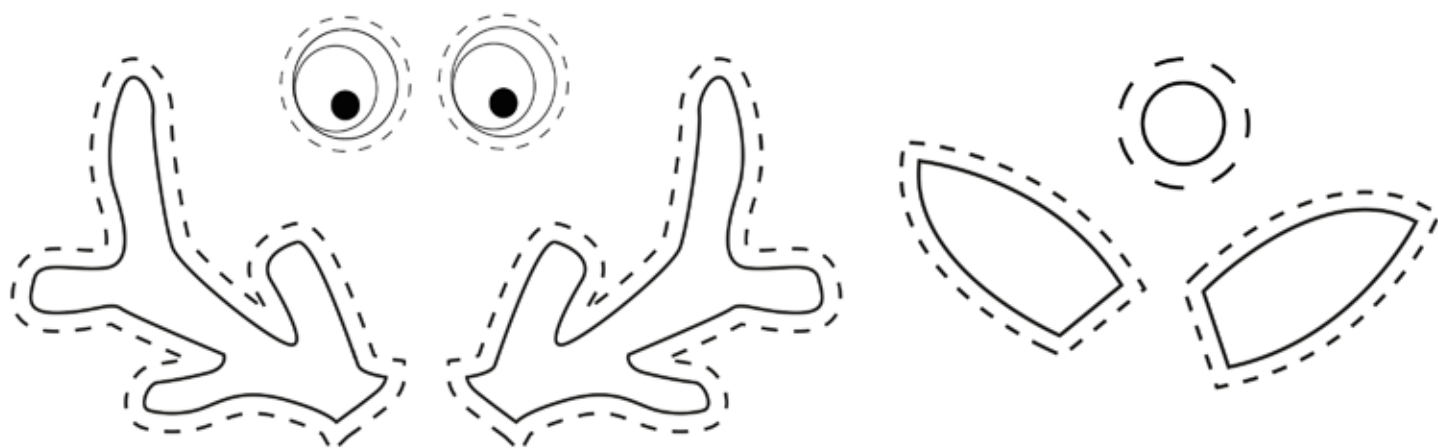
Why not?

Use twigs found outdoors to make your reindeer antlers!

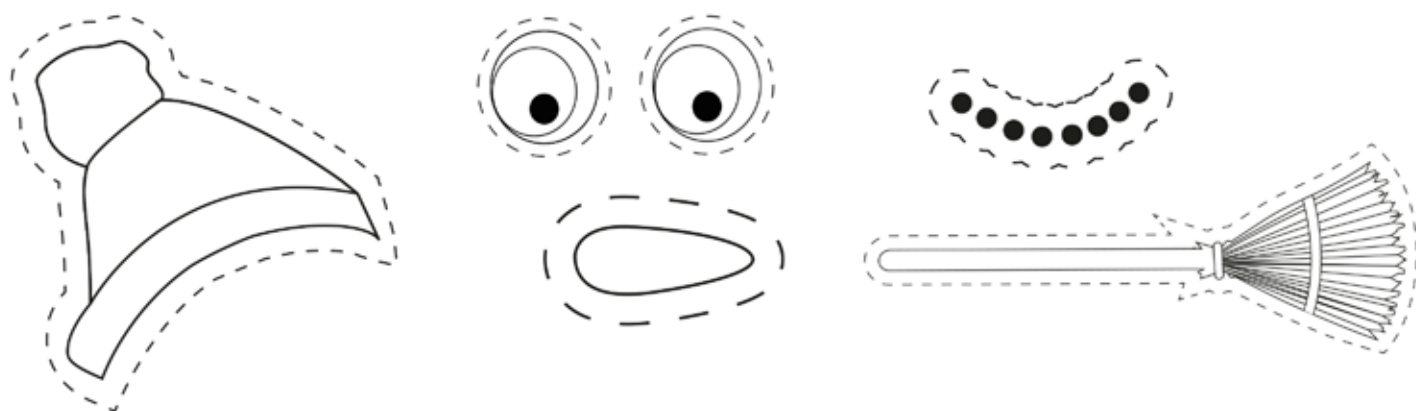

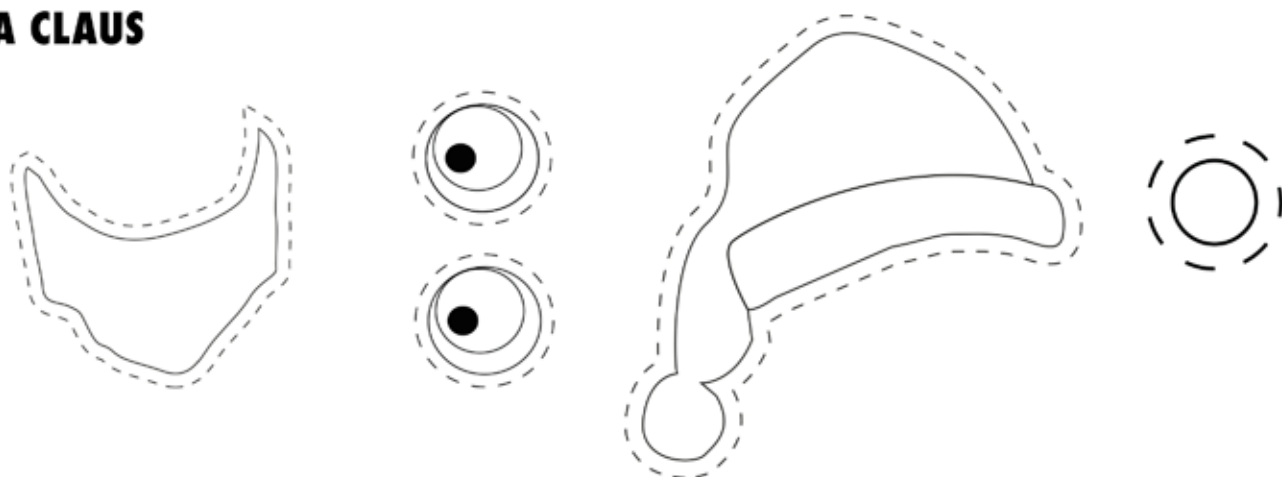

MAKE YOUR OWN GINGERBREAD PUPPET



STEP 2

Use your Pritt Stick to glue googly eyes on to your gingerbread people and don't forget to draw a smile!



STEP 3

Then, using you Pritt Stick add your decorations using things like buttons, gems, sequins, stickers, or you can even draw them on!



STEP 4

Then, use your ribbon to decorate your paper straw.



STEP 5

Finally, use your Pritt Stick to glue the paper straw to the back of your gingerbread people to make your puppets!

STEP 1

Colour or decorate the gingerbread people and decorations provided on the template and carefully cut them out.

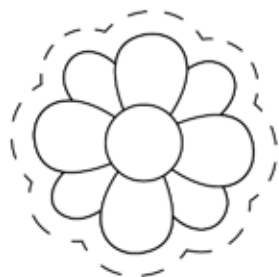
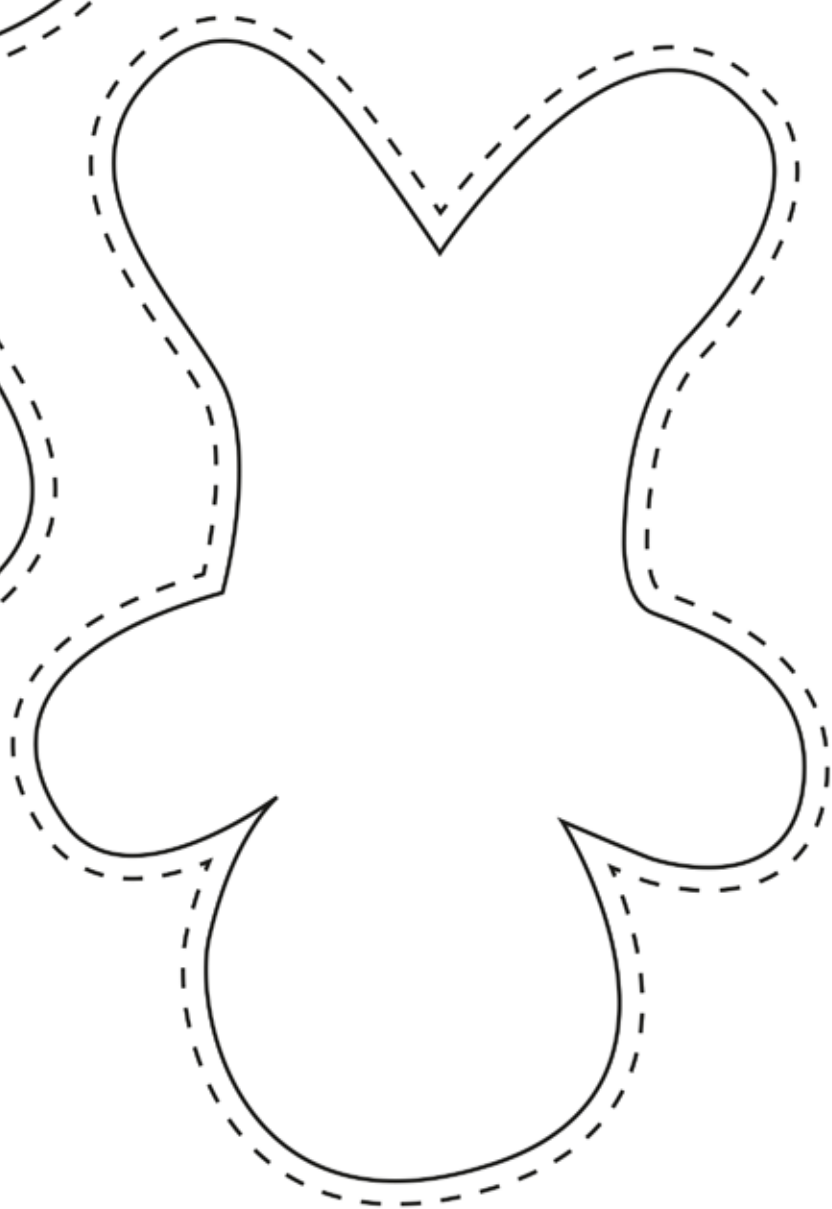
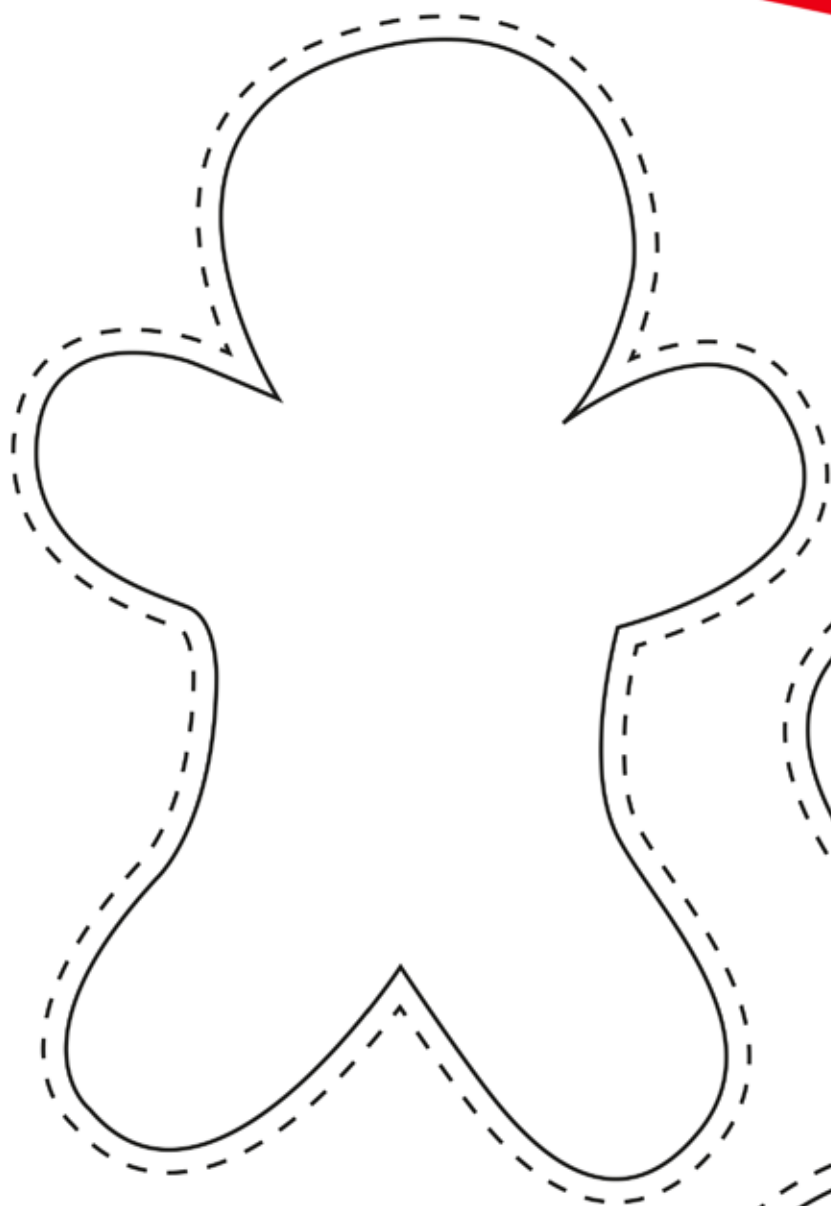

MAKE YOUR OWN CHRISTMAS WREATH

STEP 1 Cut the centre circles out of your paper plates then, using your paint and paint brushes, paint the paper plate green - remember to leave it to dry.



STEP 2 Whilst waiting for the paper plate to dry, colour or decorate the decorations provided on the template, and carefully cut them out.



STEP 3

Once your paper plate is dry, use your Pritt Stick to glue your decorations around your wreath!



STEP 4

Use your Pritt Stick to glue on any sequins or embellishments that you would like to decorate your wreath to make it festive!



STEP 5

Finally, use a piece of ribbon or string to hang up and enjoy!

- Buttons, glitter, sequins & bells

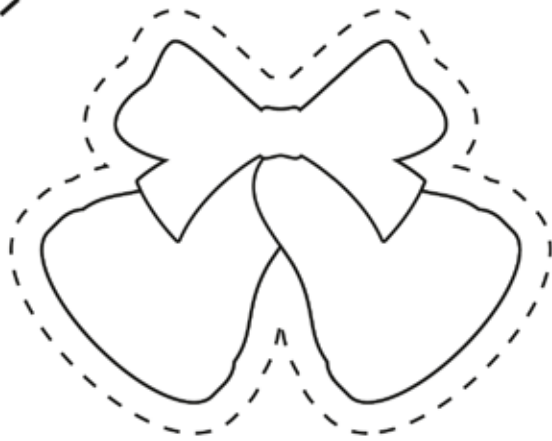
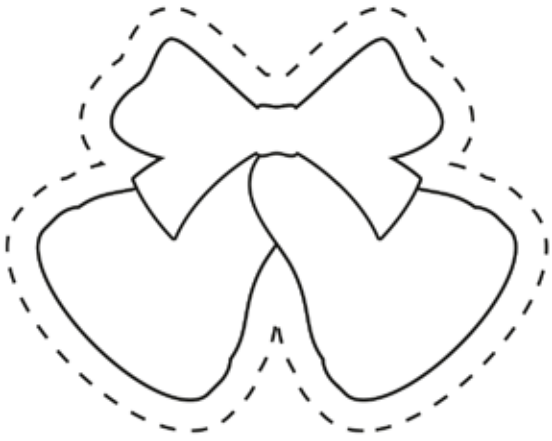


Why not?

MAKE YOUR OWN ELF DECORATION



STEP 1

Colour or decorate the Elves provided on the template and carefully cut them out.



STEP 2

Then, use your Pritt Stick to glue your Elves to card to make them sturdy. Once dry, use your scissors to carefully cut them out!



STEP 3

Then, using your Pritt Stick add your decorations using things like buttons, sequins, glitter, or bells to make your Elves festive!



STEP 4

Finally, use your Pritt Stick to glue a piece of string to the back of your Elves, ready to hang up!

- Pens/pencils
- Coloured Paper / Card
- Scissors
- Buttons, glitter, sequins & bells
- String

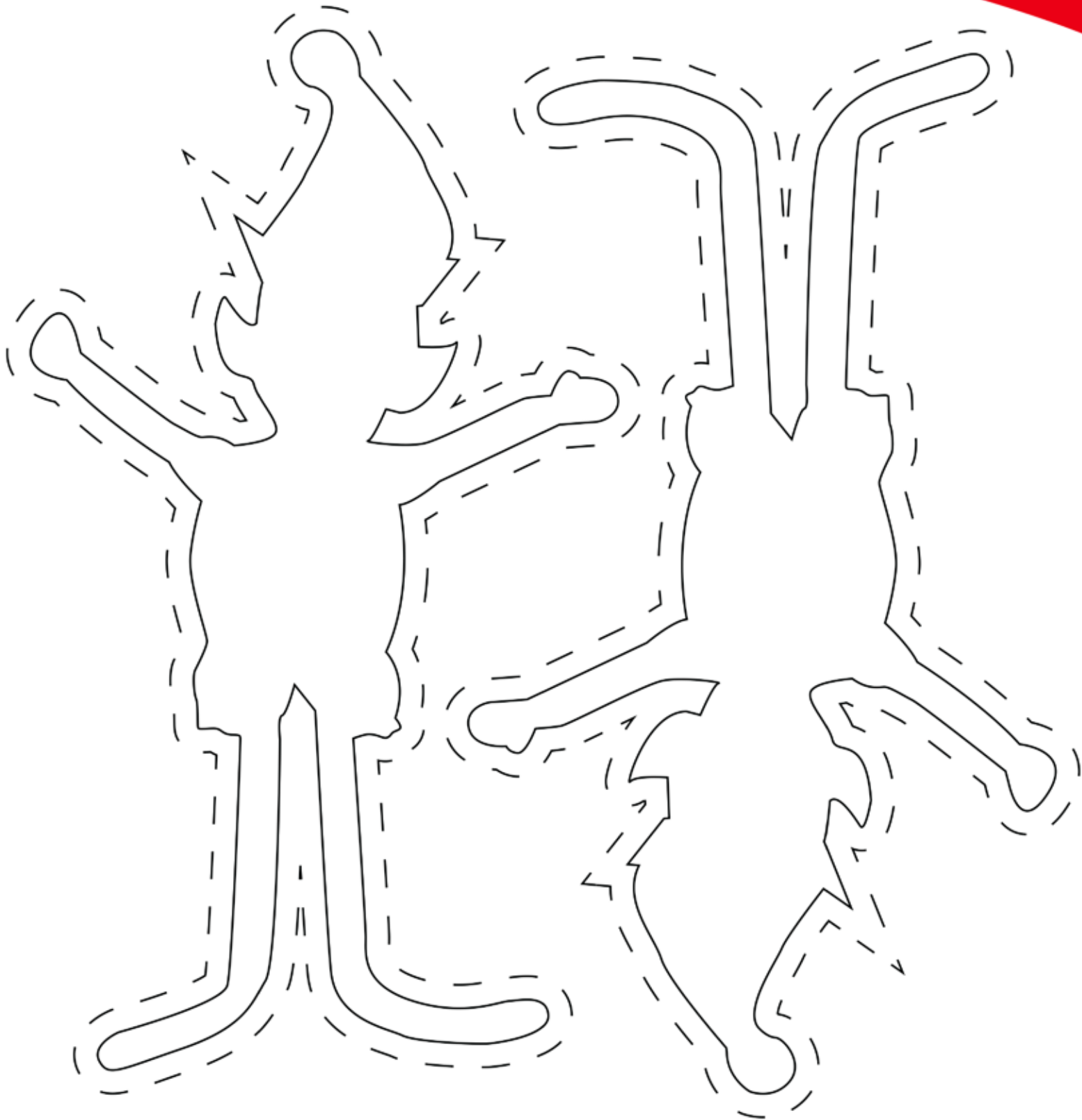
