The JOICO Color Talent Awards are open to any professional hairdresser working in a commercial environment – salon based or freelance hairdresser throughout Europe, UK, Middle East & Africa countries.

A minimum of 3 years' experience working in a commercial environment is necessary.





WHAT DOES A SUCCESSFUL ENTRY LOOK LIKE?

- Cut and Color that complement each other and work in harmony.
- Clear and sharp images can be phone images or professional images
 we need them to be clear and focus on the hair.
- You do not need to use professional models.
 A model with photogenic features will always enhance the visual impact of your entry tip from us: take a picture of the model you have in mind before you do the work and evaluate if this is the best model for the work you have in mind.
- You should ensure your look is suitable for the face shape and skin tone of your model.
- Make-up and clothes need to complement the overall look, working in synergy with the hairstyle showing the highest level of craftsmanship.

We want to see your transformations, your standout color work and the way you use color creatively to showcase your work.

STYLIST GUIDELINES

- Hair color and styling can be created using any professional hair color brand—you are not required to use JOICO products alone.
 (Of course, we will love it if you do!).
- The haircut, color, and styling must be the focal point of the look and clearly visible in the submitted photo.
- The color work must be visible and showcase skillful application, dimension, and creativity—submissions with excessive filters or edits that alter the hair color will not be accepted.
- Only natural hair is allowed—extensions, hairpieces, and wigs are not permitted.

MODEL GUIDELINES

Models (male or female) must be 18 years or older.





RETOUCHING GUIDELINES

Your photographic entry is the key element being judged. If you choose to retouch your photo, please follow these guidelines:

- Minor retouching to correct small skin or hair imperfections is allowed.
- Excessive retouching that significantly alters the hair color, texture, or overall look will be considered by the judges and may impact your score.
- No retouching is permitted on the model in the "before" image. The before photo must accurately represent the starting point of your work.

IMAGE REQUIREMENTS & GUIDELINES

- Each entry must include three images of one model:
 1 beauty image (final look) + 1 unedited "before" image + 1 unedited final "after" image.
- Only color images are allowed—black & white photos and Polaroids are not permitted.
- All images must be submitted via Instagram using the relevant Hashtags for each category (see Category information) in digital format only printed or scanned images will not be accepted.
- Excessive retouching of hair's shape, texture, or color is not allowed the judges must be able to evaluate the true artistry of the color work.





IMAGE USAGE & COMPETITION EXCLUSIVITY

- All entries must be original and created specifically for the Color Talent Awards 2025—they cannot have been used, published, or submitted to any other competition or project.
- Participants cannot share or provide their submitted images to third parties for any kind of use or publication, before the announcement of the Winners.

IMAGE USAGE ACROSS CATEGORIES

- Each category submission must feature a unique image.
- An image submitted for one category cannot be reused in another category.







Q Is there a cost to enter?

A No entry to the JOICO Color Talent awards is free.

O Who can enter?

A The JOICO Color Talent Award is open to any professional hairdresser working in a commercial environment – salon based or freelance hairdresser throughout the UK or EMEA countries.

A minimum of three years' experience working in a commercial environment is necessary.

Q Can I post my entries to you?

A Entries must be submitted via Instagram and entries delivered by other means – email or by post as an example, will not be accepted.

Q Can I use wigs or hairpieces in my photograph?

A No, wigs, hairpieces, extensions or wefts cannot be used in images.

Q Can I enter more than one category?

A Entrants may enter the same images for two different categories should it fit the brief for that category.

Q Can I post my entry on social media before submitting for the Color Talent Awards?

A Entries to the competition may not be posted on social media or in any trade media prior to the submission to the Color Talent Awards. (Entries can be submitted from June 1st-November 1st).

Q Do I have to use JOICO products?

A You do not need to use JOICO products or work in a JOICO-affiliated salon to participate—stylists who use any professional hair color brand are welcome!

If you would like to use JOICO products, you can find the Technical Manuals for all JOICO Color lines in the Briefing Kit, available for download.





Q Do I need to use a professional photographer?

A Images can be shot on your phone or by a professional photographer – it's up to you, for us it's all about the hair color.

Q Is retouching allowed?

A Re-touching minor skin or hair imperfections is allowed. Excessive retouching that significantly alters the hair color, texture, or overall look will be considered by the judges and may impact your score. Please have a close look to our Retouching Guidelines for further details.

Q Should I win, is there an option to change the prize?

A Prizes are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for an alternative prize.

Q Do I need to have all image rights if working with a professional photographer or a model from an agency?

A Yes, Entrants must guarantee the work submitted, is their own and they have the right to submit it to this competition, and that JOICO Europe has the right to publish this work in print or digitally.

Q Can I create my look on a mannequin head, training head, or headblock and submit it?

A No, only entries featuring real models will be considered valid. To ensure fairness and authenticity in the competition, all submissions must showcase a completed look on a live model. Entries created on mannequin heads, training heads, or headblocks will not be accepted.





Q What happens if the awards are cancelled?

A JOICO Europe reserves the right in its absolute discretion to add to or waive any of these terms and conditions, or to cancel the awards at any stage, in the event of circumstances arising beyond its reasonable control. In the event of cancellation, JOICO will not use any submitted work for any purpose.

Q I want to enter in the name of my salon – can I do that?

A If an entrant enters the Color Talent Award in the name of a salon business, the hair colorist must get the consent of the salon owner prior to enter into this competition. Make sure to include your name in the caption of the post—for example, Hair by [Your Name] - to distinguish your entry from others submitted under the same account.

Q What if I don't have my own Instagram account?

A If you don't have an Instagram account, click HERE to see how to create one.

Alternatively, you can submit your entry using your salon's or training academy's Instagram account, but please ensure you have their permission to do so.

Make sure to include your name in the caption of the post—for example, Hair by [Your Name] - to distinguish your entry from others submitted under the same account.



TERMS & STATE OF THE STATE OF T

By entering the Color Talent Awards 2025, all participants:

- Must be fully qualified hairdressers from the EMEA region. Stylists from all brands are welcome to participate—JOICO products are not a requirement.
- Must be 18 years or older on the date of submission, as well as their models.
- Cannot be employees or immediate family members of employees from JOICO,
 Henkel, or any of their affiliated companies and divisions.
- Agree to the processing of their provided data as part of the competition entry process.
- Must provide proof that their model has signed a release form, giving consent for their image to be used in connection with the competition.
- Automatically grant JOICO and its affiliated companies full rights to use the submitted images and any material created during the competition. Submitted photos and documents will not be returned to entrants.
- Confirm that their submitted work is original and free from third-party rights, including photographer or model restrictions.
- Accept that the judges' decisions are final and that all entries will be evaluated based on the official rules, judging criteria, and competition terms.
- The winners must be prepared to take part in publicity accompanying or resulting from the competition. No additional compensation will be awarded for such promotional activities.
- If the prize is declined or if the winner forfeits the prize under these terms and conditions, then the judges may at their absolute discretion select an alternative winner.

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CONTEST REGULATIONS JOICO Color Talent Awards 2025

ARTICLE 1: ORGANISATION

ARTICLE 2: ACCEPTANCE OF REGULATIONS

Valid participation in this contest automatically implies the unconditional acceptance of these contest regulations [hereinafter: 'REGULATIONS']. Each participant is therefore deemed to have read, understood and accepted the content of these REGULATIONS without any limitation. These REGULATIONS can be consulted at any time at www.colortalentawards.joico.eu. By participating in the JOICO Color Talent Awards each participant expressly and formally agrees to the terms and conditions related to aforementioned contest, including the privacy policy. Such acceptance implies amongst others that JOICO, to the extent necessary, will need to process personal data of a participant within the framework of the handling of the contest.

ARTICLE 3: CONTEST PERIOD

The contest takes place from 01.06.2025 at 00:00 until 01.11.2025 at 23:59. Submissions sent after this period will no longer be accepted.

ARTICLE 4: PARTICIPATION

Step 1 - Choose one of the 3 category they want to subscribe for:

- Young Creative Talent For stylists under 30 ready to bring fresh, bold ideas to life.
- **Creative Talent** For experienced professionals looking to showcase their expert skills.
- **Transformation Snapshot** For salon stylists capturing real-life color transformations.

Step 2 - Pick the mood board for inspiration.

- If they enter Young Creative Talent or Creative Talent, they need to choose from three exclusive mood boards (available on www.colortalentawards.joico.eu) designed to spark creativity. Then the participant needs to select the theme of the chosen mood board as the foundation for their look.
- If they are entering for the Transformation Snapshot category, there's a special mood board for this category—to guide their transformation while keeping it salon-real!

Step 3

- They need to create a stunning hair color look based on their chosen category and mood board.
- They need to make sure the **hair color, cut, and style are clearly visible** in their final image.
- No extensions, wigs, or excessive retouching is allowed.

Step 4 - Submit Entry

Once their masterpiece is complete, they can enter by uploading their image(s) on their own Instagram account and use the correct hashtags for the specific category, according to the Image Requirements & Guidelines:

 Young Creative Talent: 1 final beauty shot, 1 before image, and 1 unedited final image. Submit on Instagram tagging @joicoeurope and using the hashtags: #joicoeurope #YoungCreativeTalent2025 #ColorTalentAwards2025

• Creative Talent:

They must tag @joicoeurope and use the correct hashtags as described above otherwise the entry does not count! Entries can be submitted only between 1st June and 1st November 2025.

Step 5 - Winners Announcement

The winner will be chosen by our Jury panel and will be announced in January 2026.



This contest takes place exclusively via Instagram tagging @joicoeurope using the above mentioned hashtags.

The contest is accessible free of charge, with the exception of the possible normal communication, without obligation to purchase and to any natural person that is 18 years of older and domiciled in EMEA and UK region with the exception of HENKEL employees and members of their families. Employees of companies involved in any way in the development and/or implementation of this contest and their family members are also excluded from participation.

To safeguard the chances of individual consumers, no grouped entries will be accepted. Therefore, only one participation in their own name and for their own account is permitted.

ARTICLE 5: WINNERS

As with all JOICO activities we will be transparent and impartial. We have a group of the most experienced European judges who have a wealth of experience in both entering and winning awards and competitions. Judging will take place online and each judge will be sent over the images that have been submitted in each category. All images will be judged anonymously, and scores will be sent to JOICO Europe where an independent adjudicator will collate the scores.

Successful finalists in each category will be informed by email in January 2026 and announced two days later on the JOICO Europe Social Channels. Finalists will be provided with a tile to promote on their social media accounts and to share with their clients and peers.

Winners will be announced on a digital awards ceremony. The winners will be notified personally by a DM message towards them on Instagram no later than March 2026. By accepting the prize, the winners of this contest authorise HENKEL to use their name, photo, the visuals they send in for this Color Talent Awards and other visual material on which they appear (for example during the award ceremony) for campaigns related to the contest. If requested, they will cooperate in other activities related to the campaign, without any compensation other than the ordinary prize.

If a winner does not respond within 14 days to the notification Instagram/e-mail from HENKEL, the winner's prize will expire, and HENKEL has the right to choose the second best entry or not to nominate any winner.

The participant can withdraw his/her consent for the future at any given time by sending a DM to the JOICO Europe Instagram account no later than 01.11.2025. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the legality of processing based on the consent before it was revoked.

ARTICLE 11: DISPUTES

In the case of force majeure, if unforeseen circumstances would arise or in the case of dispute, HENKEL may take any decision necessary to ensure that the contest takes place properly. Its decisions are final and sovereign.







COMPOSITION OF HAIR

PRIMARY COMPONENT OF THE HAIR = KERATIN PROTEIN

JOICO products contain Keratin Protein, which supplies the correct amino acid composition to the damaged parts of the hair.



The three layers of the hair shaft:

1 Cuticle = the outermost layer of the hair that:

- a) encircles and protects the hair shaft
- b) is built out of overlapping cells, free of melanin (natural pigment)
- c) plays a major role in transferring color pigments in and out the cortex

2 Cortex = the middle layer of the hair that:

- a) represents most of the hair shaft's volume
- b) contains the hair's natural melanin
- c) can be altered through the use of chemical services
- 3 Medulla = the innermost layer of the hair that:
- a) is not always present
- b) has no known role in the hair coloring process

NATURAL PIGMENTS (MELANIN)

There are two types of pigments found in the hair:

- Eumelanin (granular): black/brown pigment
- Pheomelanin (diffused): red/yellow pigment

Varying degrees of melanin distribution create the endless variations of natural hair color.

E.a.:

Black and dark brown hair = predominantly granular pigments

Light brown hair = a mixture of granular and diffused pigments

Blonde hair = predominantly diffused pigments

CHARACTERISTICS OF HAIR

Texture The size or diameter of the hair shaft.

Three categories: Fine - Medium - Coarse

Relation to hair color: Fine hair accepts color and lightens faster

than coarse hair.

Porosity The ability of the hair to hold and absorb moisture.

Relation to hair color: Porous hair lifts more easily, accepts color and releases

color faster. Hair is more porous on midshaft and ends.

The degree of difficulty to penetrate the cuticle. Tenacity

Tenacious hair is difficult to color and known Relation to hair color:

as resistant hair.

The quantity of hair per square cm (inch) on the scalp. Density

Relation to hair color: Denser hair can trap heat at the scalp: and needs

> more product. Avoid brighter scalp areas by not pressing the hair against the scalp while processing.

Elasticity The ability of the hair to stretch and return back

to its natural shape.

Relation to hair color: If the hair breaks or does not return to its natural shape

during a test, it is in no condition to be colored.

CONCLUSIONS:

- Coarse hair is more resistant to color treatments
- Porous hair accepts coolness and rejects warmth
- Use enough product and respect maximum processing time for resistant hair
- More hair color and smaller partings should be taken for proper coverage on denser hair
- Use the K-Pak Professional Hair Repair System to rebuild the hair

THE FOUR CATEGORIES OF HAIR COLOR

TEMPORARY HAIR COLOR

KEY INGREDIENTS OF PERMANENT HAIR COLOR

The following three components are essential to create permanent hair color:

AMMONIA (pH 10):

- Swells the hair shaft
- Raises the pH
- · Opens the cuticle
- Allows penetration of the hair color molecules

HYDROGEN PEROXIDE (pH 3.5 TO 3.8):

Supplies the oxygen needed to fuel the oxidation process.

The oxidation process in hair coloring performs two tasks:

- a. Lifts the natural pigment in the cortex
- b. Develops the artificial pigment to produce new hair color

Peroxide = Water H²O + Extra Oxygen O

= Hydrogen Peroxide H²O²

= Activator: 12% (40 Vol.) is high grade

3% (10 Vol.) is low grade

The higher the volume of peroxide, the more aggressive the oxidation process and the stronger the lifting ability of the color will become.

INTERMEDIATE DYES:

- These are the oxidative dyes used to produce permanent hair color
- Provide extra richness and depth to each individual color
- Two different types of intermediate dyes:

a. Reflective dyes (Amino-phenylenediamine)

Responsible for the intense shine, thus avoiding dull "colored-looking" hair.

Used in abundance in Vero K-Pak Color.

b. Flat dyes (Para-phenylenediamine)

Non-reflective dyes; their use in Vero K-Pak Color is minimized;

however, some are used to aid in gray coverage

LAWS OF COLOR

Hair color is based on the laws of color, which revolve around the interaction of the three primary colors. Let's review:

PRIMARY COLORS

There are only three pure colors: "primary colors". Primary colors can be divided into Cool and Warm Tonalities. From these three colors, all other colors can be created when mixed in varying proportions.


A primary and a neighbouring secondary mixed together in equal proportions create a tertiary.

When mixing three primary colors together, Blue can no longer dominate.

Example: 50% Blue + 25% Red + 25% Yellow = a neutral brown. The three primaries can not be mixed together without browning out. The basic color of all naturally pigmented hair, from the darkest to the lightest, is a variation of brown.

THE COLOR WHEEL

The Universal Law of Color states that every color imaginable can be formed by mixing the three primary colors: Yellow, Red and Blue.

HOW TO USE THE COLOR WHEEL

- To enhance or create a color, work around the color wheel
- To refine (neutralize) a color, use its direct opposite on the color wheel.
 Refinement is commonly known as neutralizing color or 'browning out'

Example: Violet refines (neutralizes) yellow. Refinement occurs by combining a primary yellow and an opposing secondary violet, which is composed of two primaries blue and red. In doing so, you are mixing all three primaries together, thus creating a form of brown.

THE LEVEL SYSTEM AND REMAINING PIGMENT CONTRIBUTION

• A level is a measurement of depth, from dark to light:

Level 1 = the darkest

Level 10 = the lightest

• The international level system is used to define the lightness or darkness of natural hair color and the palette of hair color shades

RPC is crucial because it determines the tonal selection when lifting.

You may choose to either enhance or neutralize the RPC by working with the Color Wheel.

- The first primary to be removed is blue exposing the warmer red and yellow tones
- Varying shades of red/brown are seen when lifting from darker levels
- The RPC changes from level to level
- To neutralize the RPC choose its opposite color on the Vero K-Pak Color Wheel
- To enhance the RPC choose a color by working around the Vero K-Pak Color Wheel
- When lifting, RPC has the ability to overrule the artificial pigmentation





FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

- · Artificial color will not lift artificial color
- The hair's density, texture, porosity, elasticity and tenacity affect the hair color process
- The higher the volume of peroxide used, the less deposit you will obtain

STEPS TO FORMULATION


- 1 Define the natural level using the Vero K-Pak Color swatch book or the JOICO Consultation Kit. Examine the client's regrowth and scalp area. If gray is seen first, the client's hair is more than 50% gray. Follow the instructions located in the "Gray Coverage/Gray Coverage Base Choices" section
- 2 Determine the color level on the midshaft and ends as well as the tonal value
- 3 Identify the client's desired level using the Vero K-Pak Color swatch book or the JOICO Consultation Kit. Use this level in your color formula
- 4 Determine the client's desired tone. Identify the Remaining Pigment Contribution (RPC) at the desired tone using the RPC chart. The RPC will need to be enhanced or refined (neutralized) to create the client's desired tone. Use the color wheel to determine the correlating Vero K-Pak Color base that will enhance or refine the RPC
- 5 Analyze the characteristics of the hair
 - Texture coarse or fine
 - Density how much
 - Porosity affects all aspects of hair color
 - Elasticity condition
 - Tenacity especially important in gray coverage
- 6 Determine the proper volume of Veroxide. Decide how many levels of lift are required to reach the desired level using the Veroxide usage and timing chart
- 7 Establish your working procedure and application method and record this information onto the client consultation card

Note: When the natural base level falls between two different levels and you want to lift the hair to a lighter level (color), judge the natural base at the darkest level. This is important to accurately determine the level of lift you want to achieve.

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES FOR GRAY COVERAGE

- Determine the percentage of gray hair:
 - If gray is seen first, then your client is more then 50% gray
- If the natural level is seen first, then your client is less then 50% gray
- Examine all areas of new growth temple, front hairline, crown, nape and sides. Your final formulation will depend on what you observe throughout the client's new growth area
- Adjust your formula based on the percentage of gray as observed during the retouch application If your client had 25% of gray hair two years ago, chances are she could be 50% gray now
- All shades level 4 or darker will cover gray due to high percentage of dye load, except cool red shades. These follow different rules, see below
- Ash and Blue Ash series are not designed to cover more then 50% gray

MAXIMUM GRAY COVERAGE

- 1 Define the natural level and percentage of gray
- 2 Determine the client's desired level
- 3 Identify the client's desired tone and the RPC at the desired level using the RPC Chart
- 4 Determine the appropriate gray coverage base to intensify or neutralize the RPC
- 5 Select Veroxide 6% (20 Vol.) for optimum gray coverage
- 6 Check the density of the hair and size of the regrowth to determine the necessary amount of color needed for optimum gray coverage
- 7 Process for a full 45 minutes for maximum gray coverage

Up to 50% gray:

All shades will cover with the exception of the cool red shades 4RV, 4VR, 4FV, 5RM, 5XR, 5RR, 6RR, 7XR and BA series. N series will respect the cool character the most and is thus the best choice. The BA series must be mixed with N as of 25% gray for optimal coverage.

HAIR COLOR FADAGE

- Incorrect volume of developer
- Incorrect application and timing
- Incorrect post color services and home maintenance

GUIDELINES FOR LONGER LASTING RED SHADES

- Lift the natural pigment to a level 7 (Dark Blonde) for the brightest reds. The underlying pigment on a level 7 is Orange. The longest lasting Red shades are those utilizing the hair's own natural pigment contribution
- Reds can not be timed in the same way as the other series and should be brought through the shaft
 and ends of the hair within 15 minutes after the regrowth portion of the service is completed. Not
 pulling the color through within that time frame generally results in banding and flat ends
- Process for a full 35 minutes with 3% (10 Vol.) Veroxide or 45 minutes with 6% (20 Vol.) Veroxide
- Red shades loose their intensity at a grater rate than others. A rule of thumb is to mix with Gold shades:

Example: 6RR + 6N ➤ Red fades first leaving a brown

6RR + 6G ➤ The hair retains much more of its vibrancy and balance


Example: 8RG + 8N ➤ Red fades and leaves a warm tan tone

8RG + 8G ➤ 8G is a true gold, after weeks of shampooing, the hair will retain much of its original vibrancy

- Higher volumes of Veroxide may be necessary when lifting to achieve the desired red level. These
 give more lift and less deposit. Less deposit may sometimes lead to quicker fading. Process for the
 maximum amount of time. Recommend the client to return for a retouch and refreshment of midshaft
 and ends sooner than the traditional 4 week period. When refreshing midshaft and ends, use:
 3% (10 Vol.) Veroxide or VeroGlaze
- An adjusted Vero K-Pak Color formula should be applied when the color on the midshaft and ends has
 faded. The Vero K-Pak Color formula for the midshaft and ends should be adjusted according to the
 present shades on the midshaft and ends. You can choose to reduce or eliminate the Natural, Gold or
 Beige Series when they were present in the regrowth formula

- For extremely faded midshaft and ends (two or more levels lighter), repigmentize prior to color application
- Use a shifting technique when coloring hair red for the first time. This technique uses a lower volume developer at the scalp than through the midshaft and ends. This will eliminate "hot roots" and ensure more consistent results from scalp to ends
- Overlay Vero K-Pak Reds with a complimentary Color Intensity shade to further reconstruct the hair, seal the cuticle and add intensity and longevity to your red shade
- Use the K-Pak Professional Hair Repair System or Defy Damage ProSeries 1 & 2 in combination with your in-salon color service for longer-lasting results

VERO K-PAK | PREPARATION SERVICES

PRELIMINARY PATCH TEST

To determine whether allergy or hypersensitivity exists, a preliminary patch test should be performed. The following test should be done 48 hours before every application.

- 1. Use soap and water, wash an area about 2 cm (1-inch) in diameter on the inside of the elbow or behind the ear, touching the hairline. Pat dry with cotton
- 2. Prepare a test solution by mixing the exact formula to be used
- 3. Apply mixture to test area using an absorbent cotton-tipped applicator
- 4. Permit the area to dry. Do not cover or disturb it for 48 hours
- 5. Examine the area after 48 hours. If no reaction has occurred, proceed with hair color service

Caution:

- DO NOT USE hair color if any of these danger signs appear:
 Burning, itching, swelling, eruption, irritation, redness or abnormal reaction.
 If these signs appear during the test period, color must not be applied.
- This product should not be applied if the scalp shows evidence of cuts, abrasions, eruptions, open wounds or any other abnormal condition.
- The Vero K-Pak Color System is for professional use only. No product is to be taken internally or used for coloring eyelashes or eyebrows. Avoid contact with eyes. If any of the mixture should get into the eyes, rinse immediately with a large amount of water and call a doctor. Always wear suitable gloves. Store in a cool, dry place. Keep all hair color products out of the reach of children.

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

- Perform a preliminary patch test and a K-Pak Professional Hair Repair System before any haircolor service
- Divide hair into four sections before application
- ½ cm (¼-inch) partings must be taken for proper coverage
- K-Pak Professional H.K.P. should always be misted on the midshaft and ends in case these are porous
- Never apply heat to any Vero K-Pak Color service

TYPE 1: GOING LIGHTER

A: Standard method

- Apply Vero K-Pak Color 1 cm (½-inch) from scalp to ends, making sure each strand is completely covered
- 2. Time for 20 minutes until a definite color change can be seen
- 3. Mix fresh Vero K-Pak Color formula. Apply to scalp area and reapply over lengths and ends
- 4. Begin timing according to the Veroxide Usage Chart for developer chosen

B: Alternative for going lighter = Color shifting

- 1. Formulate color using correct Veroxide for desired level of lift
- 2. Mix Vero K-Pak Color formula with higher volume than desired in step 1
- 3. Apply the formula of step 2, 1cm (½ inch) from scalp to ends
- 4. Time for 20 minutes until definite color change can be seen
- Mix fresh Vero K-Pak Color formula using the Vero K-Pak Color Veroxide chosen in step 1 and apply this formula at the scalp area
- 6. Begin timing according to the Veroxide Usage Chart for developer chosen in step 1

TYPE 2: GOING DARKER

- 1. Apply Vero K-Pak Color mixture to the outline of each section for control
- 2. Apply Vero K-Pak Color mixture from scalp area up to the ends
- 3. Begin timing according to the Veroxide Usage Chart for developer chosen
- Apply Vero K-Pak Color formula to the porous ends for the last 10 to 15 minutes depending on porosity (reds should be brought through the porous ends immediately for maximum development)

APPLICATIONS | Retouch applications

TYPE 1

Normal retouch/slightly faded midshaft and ends

- 1. Apply Vero K-Pak Color formula to the regrowth in the outline of each section
- 2. Apply the formula to the remaining regrowth in each section
- 3. Time according to the Veroxide Usage Chart for developer chosen
- 4. Mist with K-Pak Professional H.K.P and work the color through the hair strands for the last 15 minutes of processing time. Adjustment of formula (i.e., adding warm pigments) may be necessary to obtain the desired tone. Take a strand test for proper timing

Note: Reds should be pulled through within 15 minutes of completing new growth application.

TYPE 2

Extremely faded (two or more levels lighter) midshaft and ends

- 1. Repigmentize midshaft and ends following all repigmentizing instructions in the Corrective Color section thoroughly
- 2. Apply Vero K-Pak Color formula to the regrowth in the outline of each section
- 3. Apply the formula to the remaining regrowth in each section
- 4. Begin timing according to the Veroxide Usage Chart for developer chosen
- 5. Create a new midshaft and ends formula. Analyze the tonal results achieved through repigmentizing. What color bases would be the best choice to enhance or refine (neutralize) the tone present on the newly repigmentized midshaft and ends?
- 6. The final formula can be mixed with:
 - 3% (10 Vol.); after applying, time for 30 up to 35 minutes
 - Mist JOICO K-Pak Professional H.K.P. on the midshaft and ends before application

Note: Remember, porous hair accepts coolness and rejects warmth!

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

- Perform a preliminary patch test and use the K-Pak Professional Hair Repair System
- Divide hair into four sections prior to application
- Take ½ cm (¼-inch) partings for proper coverage
- K-Pak Professional H.K.P. should always be misted on midshaft and ends
- Let the VeroGlaze mixture sit for 5 minutes after mixing. This allows the ammonia to dissapate ensuring deposit only results
- Apply VeroGlaze mixture to the outline of each section for control
- Apply VeroGlaze mixture to the rest of the hair
- Never apply heat

TONE ON TONE

- Apply to clean damp or dry hair from scalp to porous ends
- Apply to porous ends during the last 5 to 10 minutes of processing
- Maximum, normal and minimum intensity are all options, depending on desired result and hair's porosity

AFTER A PERM OR RELAXER OR AS A TONER ON PRE-LIGHTENED HAIR

- Apply to damp hair from scalp to porous ends. Do not stretch the fresh curl or pre-lightened hair
- Apply to porous ends for the last 5 to 10 minutes of processing
- Normal to minimum intensity are the best options
- A strand test is always recommended prior to toning

GRAY BLENDING

- Apply to dry hair from scalp to porous ends
- Apply to ends for the last 5 to 10 minutes
- Maximum or normal intensity are the best options

RETOUCH

- Apply to regrowth area
- Apply to previously color-treated midshaft and ends for the last 5 to 10 minutes, depending on porosity and amount of fading
- Consider using a maximum or normal intensity at the regrowth area and minimum intensity at the midshaft and ends for full processing time

Note: Although demi-permanent colors are meant for gradual pigment release, there may be a situation when a client still has a large amount of artificial pigment in the hair from the last demi-permanent application. In this case a retouch application is necessary.



APPLICATIONS | High Lift and Ultra High Lift applications

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

- · Perform a preliminary patch test
- · Apply to dry hair to ensure maximum lift
- Divide hair into four sections before application
- Take ½ cm (¼-inch) partings for maximum lifting ability
- Mist K-Pak Professional H.K.P. on the midshaft and ends
- Never apply heat

VIRGIN APPLICATION

- Apply the Vero K-Pak Color High Lift/ Ultra High Lift mixture through midshaft and ends, starting 1cm (½-inch) away from the scalp
- 2. Time for 20 minutes or until a definite color change can be seen
- Mix a fresh formula, apply the mixture to the scalp area out over the midshaft and ends
- 4. Time for 60 up to 65 minutes

Recommendation for porous ends:

Leave out the porous ends during your virgin application method. Apply High Lift Mixture to the ends for the last 5 to 20 minutes, mist with K-Pak Professional H.K.P. Check ends every 5 minutes of your total timing. It is also possible to adjust the formulation to add the Remaining Pigment Contribution that is absent from the hair.

RETOUCH APPLICATION

- Apply Vero K-Pak Color High Lift mixture to the outline of each section for control
- 2. Apply mixture to regrowth area only (do not overlap!)
- 3. Time for 60 up to 65 minutes

Note: Vero K-Pak Ultra High Lift series contain heavier and cooler pigment load therefore we do not recommend to emulsify or pull the color through to lengths and ends as this may create matte end results.

APPLICATION TIPS

- When the hair around the hairline is fine-textured and/or porous, apply your color the last 15 to 20 minutes of the total processing time
- Tell the client to return for a retouch every three weeks (4 weeks maximum)
- If longer than four weeks, the regrowth will go beyond the warm zone of the scalp. Waiting over four weeks makes achieving maximum lift very difficult, and results in a gold (warm) band
- Remember texture, density, tenacity, porosity and elasticity will affect the success of maximum lifting and depositing results
- If a level 10 Gold, Natural or Beige is required starting from a natural level 7, High Lift Series can be mixed with 2 parts 9% (30 Vol.) to create a level 10 color





ESSENTIALS OF LIGHTENING

Lightening is designed to decolorize hair. The lightening process breaks down the melanin granules (natural pigment).

Hair goes through different stages to reach the lightest, palest blonde. The stages of the lightening chart demonstrate the various stages of exposed pigment.

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

BLEACHING

- 1 Analyze the natural level, the condition, porosity of the hair, and determine how many levels of lift you need in order to get your desired end result. The strength of Veroxide needs to be adapted accordingly
- 2 How thick you mix your bleach and your choice of developer will depend on the lift desired, the tenacity of the hair and your speed as a haircolorist. A thicker bleach mixture works faster than a thinner bleach mixture. The addition of more peroxide dilutes the ammonia content, resulting in a slower lift
- 3 It is essential that you do NOT OVERLAP during a bleach retouch application. Overlapping causes porous bands and breakage
 - **Helpful hint #1:** Apply K-Pak Professional H.K.P. to previously lightened hair for instant reconstruction
 - **Helpful hint #2:** If breakage has been noted prior to a bleach retouch, apply K-Pak Hydrator as a barrier to protect the previously lightened hair
- 4 To avoid "golden bands", make sure pre-lightener has an even consistency when bleaching Helpful hint #1: If the regrowth or midshaft areas have not been lifted evenly, reapply bleach formula to gold areas prior to toning
 - **Helpful hint #2**: If the regrowth is more than 1 cm (½-inch), consider the hair as a virgin application
- 5 The Veroxide used will determine how long the bleach will continue to lift (stops lifting after 60 minutes). If the hair is not at the desired level of lift, re-mix a fresh batch of bleach and reapply
- 6 If the hair is lifting unevenly, rinse and reapply new mixture to uneven areas

BLEACHING AND TONING

- 1. Train your eye to differentiate exposed pigment. This is vital to the success of your color
- 2. If a bleach appears to have stopped lifting and all stages have not been reached, the hair still has the capacity to lighten. Continue processing for a longer period of time, or opt for a second bleach application
- 3. Toners are pastel colors that do not have enough pigment to refine excessive warmth in hair that has not been lifted enough. To create the desired tone, you must achieve the correct amount of lift first
- Pre-lighten hair one level lighter than the desired level. The palest yellow stage is ideal for optimal toner refinement

- Apply bleach mixture to dry hair
- K-Pak Professional H.K.P. should always be misted on the midshaft and ends
- Never apply heat
- Apply with highlighting method of choice

ON-THE-SCALP

- Perform a preliminary patch test before any hair color service
- Strand testing is required to ensure an accurate result
- Maximum 6% (20 Vol.) for on-scalp lighteners
- Apply Defy Damage ProSeries 1 when hair is in a good condition and in need of damage prevention
- · Apply bleach mixture to dry hair
- Hair must be divided into four sections before application
- Take ½ cm (¼-inch) partings for optimum lift and even results
- K-Pak Professional H.K.P. should always be misted on the midshaft and ends
- Never apply heat
- Execute step 1, step 2 and step 3 of the K-Pak Professional Hair Repair Service or Defy Damage Shampoo followed by Defy Damage ProSeries 2
- To tone the hair follow toner instructions

Note: Damaged or severely damaged hair can not be bleached. Recommend the K-Pak Professional Hair Repair service as a reconstructive in-salon treatment and the K-Pak regimen as a home maintenance follow-up regimen. 



- Do not use a developer!
- Do not mix with permanent or demi-permanent colors such as Vero K-Pak Color, Vero K-Pak Chrome, LumiShine permanent color or LumiShine demi-permanent options.
- Wear gloves to avoid staining.
- Follow lightening guidelines to ensure you lift natural hair to the proper level to achieve optimal results.
- Apply Color Intensity shades to clean, dry hair.
- Process for 20 minutes.
- Rinse thoroughly for several minutes (rinsing different shades separately).

Intensity guidelines	
Maximum	Use Color Intensity directly from tube (full strength)
Medium	2 parts Color Intensity Shade with 1 part Color Intensity Clear Mixer
Moderate	1 part Color Intensity Shade with 1 or 2 parts Color Intensity Clear Mixer
Pastel	Use Color Intensity Clear Mixer as your base. Gradually add your desired Color Intensity Shade and stir until desired shade appears

Note: In stead of using Clear Mixer, use a lighter pastel shade to mix with your Color Intensity shade when more pigment is required then with Clear Mixer.

Removing Intensity shades

Most Color Intensity shades can easily be removed by briefly applying a lightener. You can use VeroLight Powder Lightener or Blonde Life Lightening Powder with 10 or maximum 20 Volume developer (JOICO Developers). Certain shades are very difficult to remove with lightener, especially shades with red tones. In this case, we recommend Vero K-Pak Color Base Breaker Cool with 20 Volume Veroxide. Timing in both cases is visual timing.

APPLICATIONS

GUIDELINES

- Perform a preliminary patch test before any hair color service.
- Follow Pre- & Post Color Service (see p. 6) depending on the condition of the hair.
 When hair is damaged and needs repair, use K-Pak Professional Hair Repair System; when hair needs damage prevention, use Defy Damage ProSeries.
- For maximum vibrancy, pre-lighten hair. Sometimes prelightening is not required when the hair is light
 enough. Example: Magenta can perfectly be used on level 7 and lighter.
- Tone the hair if necessary (if hair lifted uneven or when using cool tones afterwards). Find toning examples
 in table below.
- Always apply to dry hair. When using on damp hair, pigments will be diluted.
- Thicker product-consistency requires application on thin sections at a time. When applying Color Intensity
 in foils, always go back and check saturation by opening the foils in the opposite direction after finishing
 initial application.
- K-Pak Professional H.K.P. can be misted on midshaft and ends when hair is damaged.
- Direct dyes cause staining. Wear gloves and be precise with application.
- What you see in the bowl is what you get on the hair (counts for most shades).
- Color Intensity shades are intermixable shades, but keep general color rules in mind.
- Processing time can be varied depending on the desired result. Example: certain pastel shades produce stronger result when left on the hair for the full 20 minutes and can therefore be processed for only 10 minutes.
- When melting two shades together, immediately massage the point where the two colors meet.
 For an even result, apply shades in small sections thoroughly saturating hair.
- Do not allow Color Intensity shades opposite each other on the color wheel (complementary colors) to merge into one another; this can create a "brown out" or an undesirable result.
- When doing techniques, do not let Color Intensity and other permanent or demi-permanent colors touch each other. This will create a "brown out".
- Shades with blue and green: blue pigments will dominate on the more porous areas.

TIPS

- The ideal prelightening level for each shade is mentioned on each tube.
- Color Intensity is great to use as a top coat to intensify or change the hue of your permanent or
 demi-permanent color result. For example: After having completed a Vero K-Pak Color 5XR or
 LumiShine 5RR color application, including post color care and drying, apply Color Intensity Magenta and
 process for 20 minutes for a deeper red with a beautiful magenta glow.
- Do not use any crème lighteners when using light or pastel shades.
 The low pigment in light and pastel shades is not strong enough for deposit after an oil-based lightener.
 Use powder lighteners.
- Mixtures of any kind of Color Intensity Pink with Yellow will create an orange tone.

Color Intensity must be shampooed from the hair to thoroughly remove excessive direct dyes from the hair immediately after the color service. This will eliminate staining and prevent color bleeding afterwards.

FUNDAMENTAL GUIDELINES

Rinse until the water runs clear. Towel blot.

Tip: Try to use luke-warm cold water, this will aid the longevity by keeping the cuticle as closed as possible.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Recommend the Colorful or K-Pak Color Therapy for the client to use as a home maintenance regimen.
 Recommend Blonde Life Violet Shampoo to maintain cool blond tones.
- 2. Inform the client that color molecules need time to bond. The client should avoid shampooing the hair for 24 to 48 hours after the color service to prevent color fading and provide longer-lasting results. The client may rinse/wet the hair, if necessary.
- 3. Advise Weekend Hair (Dry shampoo) to postpone shampooing for even longer longevity



The primary difference between demi-permanent and permanent haircolor is permanent color's ability to lift the pigment in natural hair.

HOW TO USE THE COLOR WHEEL

The Laws of Color state that every color imaginable can be formed by mixing the three primary colors yellow, red and blue. Mixing the three primary colors together with specific proportions creates brown.

- Natural hair contains all three primary colors. The primaries are present in varying amounts creating lighter to darker shades of haircolor.
- To refine (neutralize) a color, use its direct OPPOSITE on the Color Wheel. Refinement is commonly known as neutralizing color. For example, use a blue-based shade to neutralize a brassy-orange tone.

THE LAWS OF HAIRCOLOR

Haircolor is based on the laws of color, which revolve around the interactions of the primary colors red, yellow and blue.

PRIMARY COLOR

Mixing primary colors creates a "browning out" effect, resulting in natural brown without coolness or warmth.


NOTE: Brown is the basic color of all naturally pigmented hair - from darkest to lightest variations.





TWO PRIMARIES CREATE A SECONDARY COLOR

Two primaries mixed together in equal proportion create a secondary color.










CREATING TERTIARY COLOR

Mixing a primary and a neighboring secondary in equal proportion creates a tertiary color.







UNDERSTANDING UNDERLYING PIGMENT

When lightening the hair with a lightener or lifting the hair with permanent color natural pigment is lifted out of the hair. The remaining tone is referred to as hair's underlying pigment. When both lifting and depositing haircolor, the end result is a combination of the natural hair's underlying pigment PLUS the deposited tones.

Natural Hair's Underlying Pigment + Deposited Tone = Final Color Result

The chart below shows the underlying pigment at each level of lift and the corrective/neutralizing tone.

You can either refine or enhance the underlying pigment by choosing shades opposite (refine) or adjacent (enhance) on the color wheel. For example, to refine an orange tone, use a blue-based shade to "correct" for a neutralized result.

When lengths and ends are more faded apply 1 level lighter (in this case 9NNA) with 20 volume on lengths and ends for 45 minutes or less (typically 20 minutes) depending on the degree of fade.
