- Do not use if rain or freezing temperature is forecasted within 12 hours of application
- Not recommended for high temperature applications i.e., inside a fireplace or chimney

DIRECTIONS

Tools Typically Required:

Caulking gun, long and thin tool to puncture cartridge seal, tooling device.

Safety Precautions:

Wear gloves, safety glasses, and wash hands after use.

Preparation:

Use above 10°C (50°F). Remove loose grout. Joints or cracks must be clean, dry, and free of frost, grease, dust, and other contaminants. Puncture inner seal and place in caulking gun to extrude.

Application:

Apply with steady pressure, filling joint, then smooth or tool joint to match surrounding mortar. Wet tool or finger to facilitate tooling.

Clean-up:

Uncured filler should be clean up immediately with warm soapy water. Cured filler may be sanded or scraped away.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

DAMAGED BY FREEZING. Store above freezing. Product should not be washed down the drain or sewers. Use an approved hazardous waste transfer facility.

LABEL PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
