Bonding Speed: Immediate when applied to substrate with light finger pressure

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Ensure all surfaces to be bonded are clean, dry and free from dust
- 2. Unroll desired length of tape from roll
- 3. Tear tape by holding tape between thumb and forefingers and applying sharp tearing action across the width of the tape:



4. Apply to surfaces taking care not to twist or crease the tape:





5. Apply light finger pressure onto the applied tape in order to ensure good adhesion:
