Prevents carpets from slipping or creasing.

APPLICATION FIELD

• For permanently adhering carpets and carpet tiles with all backings to range of floor surfaces including floorboards, plywood, bitumen, vinyl, concrete, metal, tile.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Application







- 1. Place on clean, dry floor. Unroll the tape and stick around the edges of the floor. For firmer fixing, apply further lengths crossways.
- 2. Remove lining paper and firmly press the carpet into position **Important:** tape is not repositionable.
- 3. For carpet tiles, start from the centre of the room, lay tape in criss-cross pattern to hold adjacent tiles.

Important: tape is not repositionable.
