CHARACTERISTICS

- General purpose double sided tissue tape for home, office and crafts
- Easy to remove liner backing paper
- Double sided

APPLICATIONS

Sellotape[®] Double Sided Tape is the tape alternative to glue, ideal for joining a wide variety of materials. It is a general purpose double sided tape suitable for most substrates. It is ideal for crafting, mounting and exhibition work and is hand tearable.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Ensure all surfaces to be bonded are clean, dry and free from dust
- 2. Unroll desired length of tape from roll
- 3. Tear tape by holding tape between thumb and forefingers or cut on tape dispenser serrated blade
- 4. Apply to one surface, taking care not to twist or crease the tape
- 5. Remove lining paper and immediately apply other substrate to be bonded onto top side of the tape
- 6. Apply light finger pressure onto the applied tape to ensure good adhesion

Composition	Non-woven tissue paper coated on both sides with pressure sensitive adhesive. Siliconised release paper applied to top side of tape. 12mm and 15mm wide rolls have a water based acrylic adhesive. 25mm and 50mm wide rolls have a synthetic rubber adhesive.
