DESCRIPTION

Pattex Nail Power PL 60 Construction Adhesive is a high performance adhesive for multi-purpose use on paneling, plywood, general construction, and drywall installations. The adhesive is specially formulated to withstand all types of weather conditions.

USE

Pattex Nail Power PL 60 construction Adhesive can be used in most interior and exterior construction projects. It bonds all wood to wood assemblies, whether the wood is dry, wet or frozen. Ideal for all types of home construction and repairs and versatile enough for use with drywall, paneling and plywood, concrete and most other building construction materials.

LIMITATIONS

Not recommended for use on polystyrene, foam and other plastic panels. When used for the interior, follow ventilation precautions in "Danger" section Shelf life is one year in unopened package.

PACKAGING

STORAGE

Store in cool, dry place, preferably at 70. F.5.F(21.3.C) for long shelf life. For fast, easy application product should be kept at room temperature 24 hours prior to use.

COVERAGE

32 linear feet using a 1/4" bead 14 linear feet using a 3/8" bead or one 4' x 4' panel per cartridge

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All surfaces should be clean and dry and free of dirt and foreign materials. Concrete walls must be fully cured and free of release agents. Use only flat panels. Warped panels should not be used. Cut and pre- fit all panels and other materials before applying adhesive. Cut spout to desired size (3/8" recommended) and puncture seal in spout, place cartridge in caulking gun.

DIRECTIONS

Bonding to framing

Apply a continuous 3/8" bead on all framing members, forcing adhesive into surface

Apply two parallel 1/4" beads near the edges of framing where panel edges meet. Put panel in place within 15 minutes. Apply firm pressure to entire surface. Use mechanical fasteners at the top and bottom of panels. Some panels will require attachment according to the Gypsum Assoc. Manual (GA-201-90) Adhesive Nail-on Schedule. Perimeter nail 16" o.c. for walls and ceiling and 24" o.c. in the field of ceilings.

Bonding to walls

Apply vertical 3/8" beads, 8 to 12" o.c. starting one inch from edge and forcing adhesive into surface.

Put panel in place within 15 minutes. If necessary, "flash" panel by removing from wall for 2 to 5 minutes then reposition panel.

Apply firm pressure to entire surface. Install mechanical fasteners as required in previous section. Additional bracing may be required.

Apply a one inch wide by 3/4" deep spot of adhesive for each square foot of panel.

Put panel in place within 15 minutes.

Apply firm pressure to entire surface. Install mechanical fasteners as required in previous section. Additional bracing may be required.

CLEAN-UP

Application tools and excess adhesives can be cleaned with mineral spirits following solvent manufacturer's precautions.

DANGER EXTREMLY FLAMMABLE
